

# MAER-Net 2022 Kyoto Colloquium

## - General Information -

**Train ticket:** You can buy a train ticket to Kyoto easy at the nearest railway station from the Osaka/Haneda/Narita airport. Advance booking of the Shinkansen super express and/or other express trains is not necessary before your departure.

**Mask:** You are required to wear a mask in almost all situations during your stay in Japan, including at the conference venue. Be sure to bring a mask with you.

**Access to the Shiran Kaikan (conference venue):** As shown in the conference program, there is a bus stop near the venue called “Kyodai Seimon Mae” (京大正門前). However, it is difficult to find the Shiran Kaikan for those who visit Kyoto University first time. Therefore, we strongly advise you to take a taxi from your hotel on the first day. Please show the next page to your taxi driver. It tells him/her that you want to go to the Shiran Kaikan of Kyoto University.

**Fee Payment:** Conference fee is 20,000 Japanese Yen (10,000 JPY for students). Please pay the fee in cash in JPY at the reception desk (2F). We do not accept payment by other means including credit cards. Please pay the fee of 10,000 yen for the Saturday optional dinner tour in Gion together with the conference fee.

**Commemorative Photo Shot:** We will take a commemorative photo of the Kyoto meeting with you and other participants together just after the opening address by Professor Satoshi Mizobata at 9:30 am on Friday. Don't miss it!

**Access to the Internet (eduroam):** The Shiran Kaikan provides the international education roaming service (eduroam) to access to the internet. To use the service, you need to get your ID and password from your affiliation in advance.

**Food and Beverages:** The conference fee includes lunch on both October 7 and 8, dinner on October 7, and four coffee/tea breaks. We also provide a bag of snacks on the first day and a bottled mineral water on both days. However, if you need special food or drinks, please prepare them by yourself.

**Presentation:** You have 20 minutes to present your paper. 5-min Q&A follows. The conference schedule is very tight. Reporting times must be strictly adhered to. If you wish to distribute a handout of your slides and other research materials, please bring them with you. We never accept printouts.
